Printer Setup Instructions

- Select "Interface." Choose the interface that matches the one in your computer, Ilc/ImageWriter users select "Ilc" interface: IIGS/ ImageWriter users select "NSSC Pascal" interface.
- Select "Options." If necessary, see your printer manual for specific information about line feeds and slot number. Ignore the printer device number and the secondary address choices. They have no effect on this version of the program.
- Select "Test Printer". Use the 8-inch Figure Test. Your printer should print the corners and the left edge of an 8 x 8 box. If not, you selected the wrong printer driver.
- If your printout has broken lines, your line feeds may be set incorrectly. Or, you selected the wrong printer driver.
- Select "Save Changes" after completing the Printer Setup.
- Select "Exit Print Kit" to access the Main Menu.
