### Selecting Objects


To select an object, click anywhere inside the object or anywhere on its border. If an object has None as its fill pattern (no fill pattern), click on its border.









You can also select an object by drawing a selection box around the object to be selected. Click above or below the object, and hold down the mouse button as you drag the pointer over the object until it's surrounded by the selection box. Release the mouse button.



To select a group of objects, draw a selection box around the objects to be selected. Click above or below the objects, and hold down the mouse button as you drag the pointer over the objects until they're surrounded by the selection box. Release the mouse button.




You can also select a group of objects by holding down the *shift* key and clicking on each object that you want to select.



To choose a line pattern, drag the **pen icon** to the desired pattern OR click on the left side of the desired pattern.



To choose a fill pattern, drag the **paint bucket icon** to the desired pattern OR click on the right side of the desired pattern.
