## **Getting Started**

- 1. Make sure ALL power has been turned off!
- 2. The Apple III must have an interface card in order to run the Profile. This Interface Card is installed in slot #4 in your Apple III.



- 3. After installing the Interface Card, connect it to your ProFile.
- 4. Now turn on your ProFile.
- 5. Install the Apple III Utility Disk in the Internal Disk Drive.
- 6. Now turn on the power to your Apple III.
- 7. You will see the screen below.
